

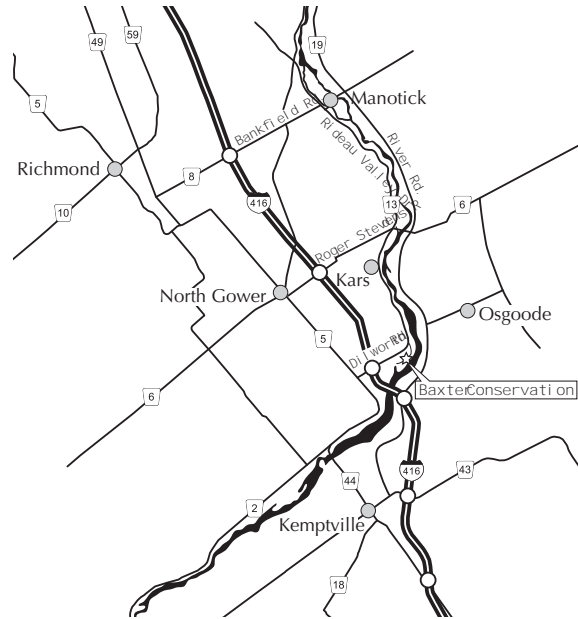
Baxter Conservation Area

Baxter is 150 acres of mixed forest, plantation forests, open meadows, ponds, marsh land, beach, group camping area and a nut tree grove.

There are six kilometers of trails and boardwalks that provide wonderful forest, river shoreline, and marsh exploration.

The Patrick McManus Interpretive Centre is Baxter's indoor camp facility providing a kitchen, washrooms and shelter from hot or stormy weather.

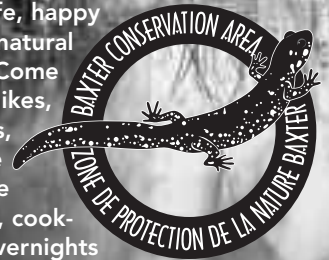

2011 Day Camps

Day Camp

- \$175 per week
- optional overnight: \$25 (includes meals and snacks)

Canoe Camp

- \$230 per week

Conservation Camp

- \$230 per week
- \$25 reduction per additional family member in the same session
- Qualified and experienced outdoor education and camping staff
- Camper to staff ratio of 8:1
- Mondays to Fridays: 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Before and after care: \$5/day 7:30 to 9:00 a.m. / 4:00 to 5:30 p.m.

Awesome Day Camps

Six one-week sessions

- July 11 to 15
- July 25 to 29
- August 15 to 19
- July 18 to 22
- August 8 to 12
- August 22 to 26

Salamanders: 6 to 8 years

- A fun filled week exploring wetland, meadow and forest habitats with different themes and activities every session.

Bullfrogs: 9 to 12 years

- Designed specifically for older campers, this program will include the above core program activities as well as small group games, challenges and adventures.

Optional Overnight Program

Thursday night of each session. Campers will sleep in tents, or the interpretive centre, and experience nature at night; stargazing, night hikes, campfires, singing and stories. Supper, breakfast and snacks included.

Cool Canoe Camps



Two one-week introductory canoe tripping sessions for campers 10 to 13 years old.

July 25 to 29, August 22 to 26

Campers will experience: tandem paddling skills, canoe tripping safety and rescue, trip planning and preparation, river ecosystem exploration and shoreline clean-up.

This camp includes a day trip on the Rideau River and overnight camp.

HOT! Conservation Camp

August 8 to 12

Baxter's Conservation Camp is open to, but not limited to, registered Scouts and Girl Guides 9 to 13 years old.

The program will follow requirements of the Scout World Conservation Award and Naturalist Badge and the Girl Guide Conservation, Ecology and Naturalist Badges.

Based at Baxter's River Cabin, activities will include: exploration of specific habitats/ecosystems, individual and group conservation projects, species identification lists, small habitat restoration projects, soil and water conservation, as well as all regular camp activities; swimming, games, etc.

The Thursday overnight is included in this camp and will include special evening activities.

Leaders for this program are registered Scouters and Trainers. All campers will receive letters of completion to take to their Units/Sections.
