

## **RIDEAU WATER LEVELS OK**

Water levels in rivers, creeks and streams throughout the Rideau watershed continue to decline since the rainfall of last week. There were no flooding problems as a result of that rain.

There is sufficient capacity in the streams to accommodate a similar amount of rainfall over the next two days. Some of the reservoir lakes remain high but flooding is not a problem.

Water flow models on the Ottawa River show that it should reach its maximum level today at Britannia (Lac Deschenes) but below flood levels. Winds are not forecast and are not expected to be a factor in how high the water gets.
