# OUTDOOR EDUCATION INTERPRETER / DAY CAMP CO-ORDINATOR

*You will work at the Baxter Conservation Area located just south of Kars.*

*There is no public transportation to the worksite; candidates should ensure they have reliable transportation prior to applying.*

*Work schedule is 35 hours a week, Monday through Friday, MAY THROUGH AUGUST*

The Rideau Valley Conservation Authority is the lead inter-municipal agency working to address river-related environmental issues and concerns within the Rideau Valley watershed. It's our job to make sure that the water is looked after by everyone in today's society so that tomorrow's generations inherit a clean, healthy, functioning watershed. We also provide residents with close-to-home natural areas and programs that are accessible and affordable. We currently own and maintain a network of nine Conservation Areas and an additional 4,500 acres of environmental land.

You will assist the Baxter Conservation Area Manager with the planning, delivery and evaluation of outdoor environmental education programs and day camps for school-age students. You will provide daily supervision of other camp staff and volunteers and perform the duties of a life guard. You will also assist with light cleaning and maintenance.

As the ideal candidate, you are a **post-secondary student** specializing in environmental studies, natural science, outdoor recreation or a related program with previous experience designing and delivering programming for school-aged children in an educational or recreational setting. Experience supervising others is an asset. You have your lifeguard certification (Bronze Cross) and Standard Level First Aid. You must have a valid G2 or better driver's license and a clean driving record. The successful candidate will be required to provide an affirmative "Police Records Check".
