Reporting to the Senior Water Resources Engineer, the Engineering Assistant is responsible for various technical, analytical and data processing tasks in the general area of water resources engineering.

Under direct supervision, you will perform a wide range of technical tasks related to hydrology, hydraulics, computer modeling, floodplain mapping and watershed management. You will collect and analyze relevant data and present engineering analyses using appropriate spreadsheet and GIS software. You will also be involved in field surveys, report writing and other related activities.

As the ideal candidate, you must hold a bachelor's degree in Civil or Water Resources Engineering. You will have some relevant experience. Competence is required in hydraulics, hydrology, computer modeling, floodplain management and data analysis. Familiarity with standard hydrologic/hydraulic models such as HEC-HMS, HEC-RAS and CFA, strong problem-solving and analytical skills, proficiency in computer applications (especially MS-Word and Excel), and basic knowledge of GIS products are desirable. You must have a valid driver's license and be able to provide an acceptable driving record.
