You will assist the Director in managing forestry services on conservation authority lands and with other management agreements. To achieve objectives and effectively manage the program you will work closely with internal and external clients to secure funding, promote community involvement and develop related resources for reforestation programs. You will also be responsible for managing the forestry budget, managing the tendering process for contractors and site inspections. You will supervise the Forestry Technician directly and collaborate closely with other coworkers in the stewardship and conservation lands team.

As the ideal candidate you hold a college diploma or higher in Forestry. You have five years of relevant experience including some experience supervising staff. You have strong interpersonal skills, some knowledge of related legislation and experience implementing projects. You enjoy working outdoors and interacting with coworkers, contractors and the community.
