Forest and Wetland Management Plans

Project Intent: Support for the development of forest, woodlot, or wetland management plans to aid in conservation efforts and improved management, and to support eligibility for provincial tax incentives

Eligible Project Components

- ▶ Management Plans developed by a professional, including, but not limited to:
 - Property mapping
 - Inventories
 - Forest harvest plans
 - Management guidelines
- ▶ Submission of five-year Progress Report and renewal of 10-year Management Plan under the Managed Forest Tax Incentive Program to maintain eligibility

Technical Details/ Considerations

- ▶ Project must demonstrate a potential to protect or improve surface water quality through a forest or wetland management plan
- ▶ To meet requirements of Provincial tax incentive programs, such as the Managed Forest Tax Incentive Program, Management Plans must be approved by a Managed Forest Plan Approver

Eligible Costs

- ▶ professional services and consulting fees

Ineligible Costs

- ▶ Taxes
- ▶ Costs associated with future reporting requirements for Provincial tax incentive programs
- ▶ Labour and machinery use of the applicant, family dependents or the applicant's business

It is the applicant's responsibility to meet all municipal, provincial and/or federal regulatory or legal requirements
